AGRICULTURE

- **Farming**
 1. Increased loans based on production
 2. Expand land irrigation programs
 3. Get a loan from the World Bank to purchase equipment that will be owned by the government, lent to cities and then used by the local farmers
 4. Reduce international export tariffs, while increasing international import tariffs

ECONOMY

- **Enterprise Zones**
 1. Create special zones that will be provided with special financial assistance based on
 1. The industry
 2. Number of people hired
 3. Projected income
- **Expand access to the Sea to increase exports**
 1. Increase access to international waters
 2. Expand
 1. Agreements with neighbors
 2. Transportation systems

EDUCATION

- **Expand Educational Opportunities**
 1. All Ugandans deserve an education
 2. Job and school training must be expanded
 3. Western Standards are needed
- **Establish developmental & occupational skills program for Ugandan Youth**
 1. Expand job skills and training, along with educational opportunities
- **Assist Teacher Unions in developing**
 1. Enhanced classroom budgets and education programs
- **Classroom subjects:**
 1. All Ugandans should understand financial literacy and be trained in computer coding/operations
 2. Establish adult classes, as well as classroom instruction for students
- **Internet and computers**
 1. Expand access to the internet
 2. Provide computers for students, as outlined below
- **Private schools:**
 1. Owners are selling schools and incurring high debts, even though they are not operating during the pandemic
- **School Openings and Dropouts:**
 1. Students need to be back in school because during the pandemic, dropout rates have increased.

ENVIRONMENT

- **Tree Planting:**
 1. Establish environmental programs that trees to protect the environment

GOVERNMENTAL REFORM

- **Candidacy Fees and Registration: simplify registration requirements**
 1. Current law restricts and denies Ugandans the ability to run for office. Help more people 'run' by eliminating education requirements & lowering fees.
- **Police Brutality**
 1. Enact & implement legislation addressing various forms of police brutality
 1. Increase police training
 2. Outlaw certain police actions – like chokeholds
 3. Require body cams to be worn and used
 4. Provide proper equipment to ensure the public safety
- **Government Officials who misuse tax payers money**
 1. Enact criminal penalties and fines for Government Officials who misuse taxpayer or campaign finance money.
- **Land Grab and Control:**
 1. Enact criminal penalties and fines for Government Officials who steal or “land grab”
- **Identifications:**
 1. Establish an ID program to help Ugandans obtain IDs, especially for work

HEALTH

- **First aid and CPR training for students and adults**
 1. All Ugandans should learn the most basic health requirements that saves lives
 1. Basic First Aid
 2. CPR
- **Hospitals: Conditions and Access**
 1. Establish programs that
 1. Educate more health care professionals
 2. Help these professionals and hospitals acquire medical equipment
 3. Expand healthcare programs that provide access for Ugandans
- **Pandemic:**
 1. Like many other nations, establish governmental assistance and loans programs for those impacted by the pandemic

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS
